

Visiting/Transient Boaters Instructions and Information

CRYCC maintains a very limited number of visitor/transient slips which require **ADVANCE RESERVATIONS.**

All visitors must be a member of a Yacht Club affiliated with the Yachting Clubs of America.

The CRYCC Marina is comprised of three docks (A, B, C), each with a limited number of visitor/transient slips and t-head berths. Maximum waterline is 60 feet. All slips and t-head berths include shore power and water hook ups.

Slip fees for overnight stays are \$2.00 per foot, plus \$8.00 for 30-amp and \$10.00 for 50-amp service (amp requirements assessed upon arrival). There are no fees for day visits.

Please note that the CRYCC Marina is not staffed – all visiting boaters are fully responsible for independently docking and securing their vessels in the slip assigned by the Transient Manager. Additionally, the marina provides NO DOCK LINES.

Upon arrival, all visiting boaters are required to register and pay dockage fees at the CRYCC pro shop. You will need to complete the dockage log with contact info, dockage dates, boat registration number and boat name. Dockage tickets must be placed in view on your boat. Contact the Visitor/Transient Manager for any dockage related issues and if you leave at a time other than indicated in your reservation.

Navigating to CRYCC on the Chester River

- Enter the Chester River either above Kent Island from the North or via Eastern Bay and Kent Narrows from the South.
- Navigate upriver via navigation markers. The Chester River has a deep channel (over 50 feet in spots), but is generally quite shallow outside of the channel.
- Once past Rolph's Wharf bend, (GREEN CAN 37), it is approximately 1 mile to CRYCC docks (located on the left side of the river facing upriver).
- Facing the CRYCC docks: – the left/south dock is "C" (floating) – the middle dock is "A" (floating) – the right/north dock is "B" (fixed).

Additional Information for CRYCC Visitors

Visitors are welcome to access CRYCC's facilities, including the clubhouse restaurant/bar, dock bar, swimming pool, golf course and driving range.

- Clubhouse Restaurant and Bar. Open for lunch and dinner Tuesday thru Sunday (closed Mondays). Reservations are required for the restaurant (410-778-3818 x2).
- Dock Bar. During summer months, the dock bar is open for drinks and lite fare Wednesday thru Saturday evenings (5pm – 8pm). Reservations required (410-778-3818 x2).
- Golf. Arrangements to play golf should be made in advance directly with the CRYCC golf pro (410-778-3818). The pro shop is open daily from 7:30 am (11:00 am Mondays) until 7:00 pm.
- Swimming Pool. The club pool is open daily from 10 am to 7pm.
- Restrooms. Restrooms and showers are available in the clubhouse. There are also restrooms in the marina parking lot behind the dock bar (lock code = 1929).
- Ice. Bagged ice is available for purchase at the ice machine behind the Dock Bar. Pay at the Pro Shop.

Visitors are expected to abide by all club rules, including:

- Dress Code. Country club casual attire is expected inside the clubhouse. Jeans and bathing suits are not permitted, and gentlemen are expected to remove their hats inside the building.
- Private Food and Beverage. Allowed only aboard boats and dockside at the slips.
- Grilling. No grilling is allowed on the docks or boats docked in the marina. Additionally, use of club grills is not permitted.
- Swimming. Only permitted in the club pool; swimming is not allowed off of boats or docks in the marina.
- Fishing. Fishing is not permitted in the marina area.
- Trash/Waste. Dispose of trash in the waterfront dumpster on the south side of the parking lot. Note that CRYCC has no accommodations for hazardous waste such as used oil, fuel, batteries, anti-freeze, etc. The Chestertown Marina and Rolph's Wharf have waste facilities.
- Dogs: Dogs must be walked on a leash and are not allowed outside the marina. Please dispose of pet waste in the waterfront dumpster on the southside of the parking lot.

Other information of interest:

- Chandlery and Fuel. Upriver, the Chestertown Marina at the riverfront of the historic district has marine fuel and pump-out available. Downriver, Rolph's Wharf also has fuel and chandlery.
- Visiting Chestertown. Historic Chestertown is a short dinghy ride by water or about a mile bike/walk north of the club on Quaker Neck Road. Key Lime Taxi is also available with advanced notice of about an hour (410-996-4950 x2).
